HAPPY TIMES

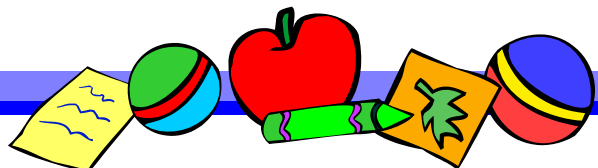
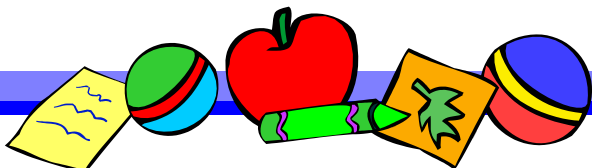

BOOK BUDDY BAGS

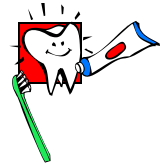

EVALUATIONS

 Evaluations were sent home last week; remember they are used as an awareness tool to see where each individual child is in their own development. Please return these evaluations during this week, Feb. 3-7. The evaluations will be done again in May and they will be yours to keep at that time. Thank you.

SPECIAL GUESTS

The month of February will bring two special guests to our preschool. The first one was Firefighter Marja; who visited on Monday and Tuesday to teach our students safety procedures in case of fire. Your child may ask you about escape routes for your home. Please go over your families escape plan and meeting place in case of a fire or other emergency that gets you out of your home. Our next visitor is my dentist, Dr. Kevin Song. He will visit the Preschool 1 class on the 25th and the Preschool 2 class will get to visit his office on the 26th.

OPEN HOUSE

We will be hosting an open house this Wed., February 5th from 6:30 - 7:30 pm. We are excited to be offering this opportunity for new families to see what our preschool is about.

TEA & TALK

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Our preschool registration for the 2014-2015 school year is now open for returning students or families. We have been able to maintain our prices for the last few years and have been pleased with that ability. However, we will need to increase our prices for next year. The registration fee will be increasing from \$65.00 to \$70.00 and the tuition for the Preschool 1 (T/Th) class will go from \$1035.00/year to \$1080.00/year or 9 monthly payments of \$120.00 each. The tuition for the Preschool 2 (M/W/F) class will go from \$1,552.50/year to \$1,620.00/year or \$180.00/month for 9 months. The preschool board strives to maintain competitive pricing as well as a quality program. If you or someone you know may be interested in our preschool, please speak with me. Early-bird registration fee before June 1, 2014 is \$60.00!



TAX TIME

Every year a few families ask about their child's tuition and whether it is tax deductible or not. Well, the answer to that question depends on the home circumstances and is either yes or no. The answer is yes, if both parents work for income outside or inside the home or one or both attend college. The answer is no, if one parent works for income outside or inside the home and one parent does not receive an income and is not enrolled in college. If you have questions about this, Debbie Tanner, who works in the church office and was one of our assistants, is a tax accountant and can answer your questions. (She also prepares taxes.) If you need the tax ID # from our preschool for your tax purposes please ask me. Thank you.
