Based on Luke 10: 30-36

Jesus tells the story of the Good Samaritan. A man who sees someone in need and helps, no matter the nationality of the man he is helping or the monetary cost he will incur for doing so. This man, the Samaritan, Jesus uses as an example to the Jewish "teachers of the law" who were trying to trap Jesus with their question of "Who is my neighbor?" Jesus plainly let them know we are to help those in need when we can.
