PAYMENT SCHEDULE REMINDERS

Preschool 1 tuition is \$1,080.00 for the year and Preschool 2 tuition is \$1,620.00 for the year. The discount for paying the yearly fee up front is still available until September 10th. Monthly payments are also accepted for those who prefer the payment plan of \$120.00/month for Preschool 1 or \$180.00/month for Preschool 2. These monthly payments are due the first week of each month, and considered late when paid after the 10th of each month.
