## BLOWING NOSES AND COVERING COUGHS/SNEEZES

For most people blowing one's own nose is a learned skill. Please help your child learn this skill by explaining the process. A person needs to keep their mouth closed and blow the air out through their nose while holding a tissue (or held by another) ready to catch anything that comes out. Covering one's mouth when sneezing or coughing is also very important. Using the shoulder or elbow to block the germs is recommended over using a hand. Our hands, obviously, will spread the germs to anything our hands touch until they are washed. We rarely touch things with the inside of our elbows or our shoulders so our spread of germs is reduced! Washing hands helps also!!
