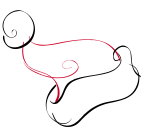
## BOOK BUDDY BAGS

## CLASS SIZE AND ALLERGY ALERT

Our enrollment is currently at 21 students. We have 9 in our Preschool 1 class (T/Th) and 12 students registered in our Preschool 2 class (M/W/F). There are no allergy alerts in the Preschool 1 class. For the Preschool 2 class we have strawberry, nut, and milk allergy alerts. Milk products are okay to send (and milk – we will have water as an option to drink every day). We ask that the food items contain no strawberries or nuts. Thank you.

## PAYMENT SCHEDULE REMINDERS

Monthly payments are \$115.00/month for those in Preschool 1 (T/R) or \$172.50/month for Preschool 2 (MWF). These monthly payments are due the first week of each month or before the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month.
