FINGER CONTROL

ADVENT SEASON

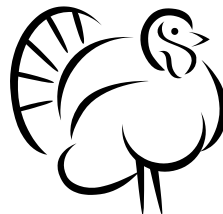

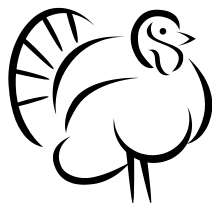
BOOK BUDDY BAGS

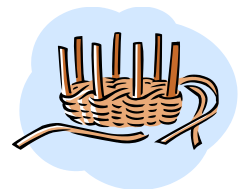


HOLIDAY FAIRE
